

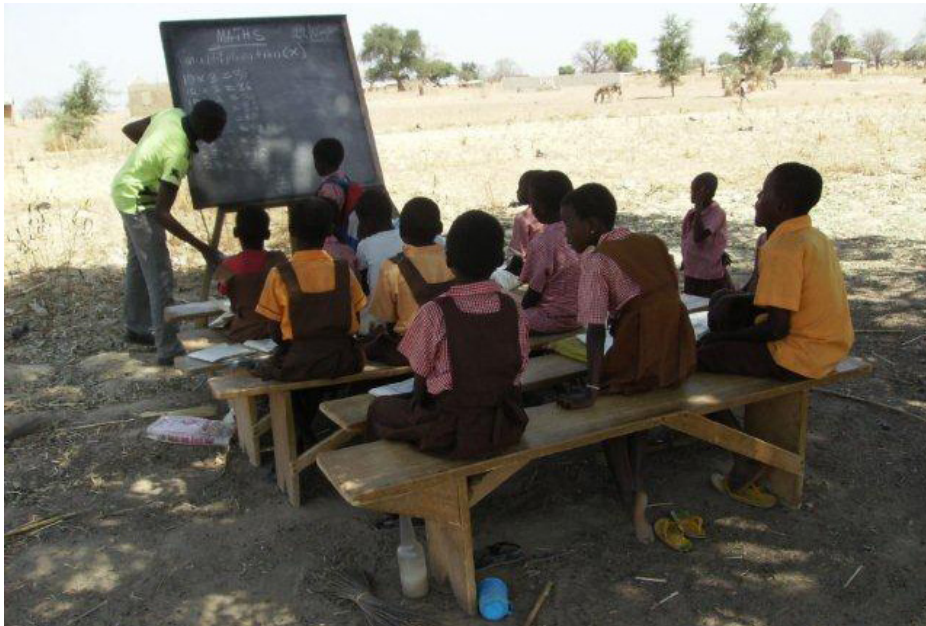
Classrooms Around The World
