**WITH JUST \$100 INA CAN ASSIST A FAMILY IN SENDING ONE CHILD TO SCHOOL FOR A YEAR.**

Children living in poverty around the world face many barriers to attending school; community attitudes, pressure to work to earn money, travel distances, dangerous journeys, unsafe schools, and health issues. INA works closely with partners on the ground in the communities where we work to eliminate these issues. Filling one receipt book of ten \$10 receipts will raise \$100...and just \$100 will allow us to help one more child to go to school.

**ONLY 5 COMPLETE RECEIPT BOOKS = \$500**

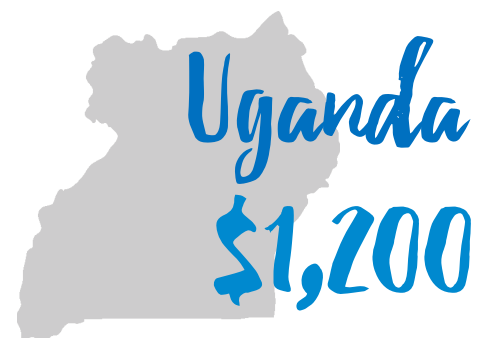
**INA CAN SETUP A CHILD PROTECTION COMMITTEE**

In Sri Lanka, many children are at risk of abuse, trafficking and child labour. Children with disabilities are most vulnerable. Child Protection Committees work within the community to advocate for the health, wellbeing and educational rights of children, as well as creating an awareness of violence against women and children.

**ONLY 12 COMPLETE RECEIPT BOOKS = \$1,200**

**INA CAN PAY A TEACHER'S WAGE FOR 6 MONTHS**

Paying and professionally developing teachers ensures reliable and quality education for children attending primary school in Uganda. Unpaid, or poorly paid, and unskilled teachers results in poor skills levels, frequent teacher absences and poor quality of teaching.



**ONLY 25 COMPLETE RECEIPT BOOKS = \$2,500**

**INA CAN ESTABLISH AND SUPPORT TWO HEALTH CLUBS**

This will help us train teachers and student leaders in health awareness to lead school-wide change in health and activity, as well as providing equipment like soccer balls and soap for handwashing. Better understanding about water quality and sanitation means better health, which leads to better educated children and less poverty.



**Myanmar**  
**\$5,000**

**ONLY 50 COMPLETE RECEIPT BOOKS = \$5,000**

**INA CAN PROVIDE ACCESS TO IMPROVED WATER AND SANITATION FACILITIES AT 6 SCHOOLS**

Often children, in particular girls, are affected by poor sanitation and water facilities at schools, many of them staying home due to illness. Improving the water supply for clean drinking water, building hygienic toilets and training the staff and families at schools leads to improved health for the children and better attendance.

**ONLY 70 COMPLETE RECEIPT BOOKS = \$7,000**

**INA CAN BUILD A NEW VENTILATED PIT LATRINE TOILET**

While all children need access to hygienic and safe toilets, girls in particular are significantly affected by limited access to toilets at schools. WHO recommends a ratio of 25:1 for girls, however the current ratio in rural Ethiopia is 266:1! Improving this statistic means increased hygiene, dignity, privacy and safety so more girls can go to school.



**Philippines**  
**\$9,500**

**ONLY 95 COMPLETE RECEIPT BOOKS = \$9,500**

**INA CAN PROVIDE 600 CHILDREN WITH SCHOOLING BASICS**

Every child needs basic supplies so they can attend school and be successful, like pencils, paper, books, and sometimes a bit of extra help with their work. Even where education is 'free', without school supplies, many children can't attend or soon drop out. Providing these items will help these children stay in school and break the cycle of poverty.

**ONLY 100 COMPLETE RECEIPT BOOKS = \$10,000**

**INA CAN EDUCATE 300 GIRLS IN RURAL AREAS**

In many remote villages in India, it is not considered safe for girls to move freely around their communities, making it more difficult to go to school. Our educational program in India allows girls to safely attend a community school, undertake vocational training, learn about child rights and receive counselling. As a result, girls develop income-generating skills and can protect themselves from exploitation.
